New dual flow pump is "best in class"

Sunfab has launched a new dual flow pump on the market under the name SCPD 76/76. It is intended primarily for forestry cranes where there is a need for high flows that provide optimal control of the crane and good interlinking properties.



The new Sunfab SCPD 76/76 has been developed by the Design Department at Sunfab in Hudiksvall. Intended primarily for forestry cranes that require high flows.

- "The difficulty facing the designers was to design a pump that could deliver two large flows, while still being sufficiently compact to be fitted to all of the power take-offs used in the market," explains Lars Häggroth, Product Manager, Sunfab. "Our new dual flow pump is without a doubt "best in class". For example, it has the very highest flow at max. 2 times 127 l/min. and the highest speed at 1,700 rpm. The SCPD 76/76 also has the smallest outer dimensions, which means that the pump can be fitted directly onto the power take-off in very confined spaces."

Delivery early 2015

The SCPD 76/76 was premièred at the Elmia Lastbil trade fair in Jönköping on 20-23 August. There was a high level of interest from the industry, and many customers are now waiting with keen anticipation for deliveries of the new pump to start in early 2015.

Our new range of SAP pumps has been developed to meet the market's requirements for light weight and high performance. The programme has now been extended to include sizes from 12 to 108 cm³/rev.



This April he made that dream come true by flying halfway round the world and ascending to Base Camp on Everest, a height of 5,500 metres above sea level. Marc trained for the arduous ascent with walking and running to improve his stamina.

Debilitating stomach illness

Unfortunately whilst in Kathmandu Marc contracted a parasitic stomach infection. This was extremely draining and was to make the climb ahead even more gruelling.

"The thin air at base camp makes climbing hard enough but with my illness it was a living hell, people will find this hard to believe but at one point it took one hour to ascend 25 metres. However the amazing view and the feeling of tranquility on the first morning made all of the hardship worth while." Comments Marc.

Avalanche killed 16 people

Three hours after leaving base camp tragedy struck Everest. An enormous avalanche killed 16 people and came within 150 metres of base camp. Marc was lucky enough to already be out of reach, but had previously met many of the 50 sherpas who were caught up in the avalanche.

Bitten by the bug

The Everest ascent was Marcs first adventure trip outside of the UK and he is positive it won't be his last.
